

Operating instructions: «The Original»

Congratulations on your choice of this Rado watch and thank you for your trust. The following instructions will help you to use your watch properly.

Classic

The model you have chosen has the following characteristics: it is water-resistant to a depth of 100 meters (330 feet), is equipped with an automatic movement with date display, has a scratchproof hard-metal bezel, a screw-down case back and a screw-down crown.

Key to diagram on inside cover flap

- (A) Crown
- (B) Minute hand
- (C) Hour hand
- (D) Second hand
- (E) Date display

Setting the time and date

- Crown (A) positions (see diagram):
- 0 = Normal position (crown screwed down to watch case to ensure water-resistance)
 - 1 = Manual winding of the watch (crown unscrewed)
 - 2 = Adjustment of the date
 - 3 = Adjustment of the time setting

Manual winding of the watch

A fully wound Rado automatic watch has a running reserve of at least 36 hours.

If the watch should stop (e.g. if it is not worn for some time or in periods of low activity), it should be wound manually.

Turn crown (A) counterclockwise until it is unscrewed (position 1).

Turn the crown clockwise several times. Then screw the crown down again into position 0 by pressing and turning it clockwise simultaneously.

Setting the time

Turn crown (A) counterclockwise until it is unscrewed (position 1). Pull out the crown to position 3. The seconds hand will stop moving. Set the correct time by turning the crown. Afterwards, press the crown back into position 1 and screw it down again into position 0 by pressing and turning it clockwise simultaneously. The watch will start running again.

Setting the date

Turn crown (A) counterclockwise until it is unscrewed (position 1). Pull out the crown to position 2. Set the correct date by turning the crown clockwise. Afterwards, press the crown back into position 1 and screw it down again into position 0 by pressing and turning it clockwise simultaneously.

Important

To guarantee optimal water-resistance, the following must be observed: after every operation using crown (A), the crown must be fully pressed in and screwed down by pressing and turning it clockwise simultaneously.

Taking care of your watch

To ensure water-resistance, we recommend that the watch is checked once a year by your authorized Rado retailer. Clean the watch regularly with luke-warm soapy water.
